CONDITIONS

1. The draw must be held on the date(s), time(s) and location specified on the application for licence, as submitted and approved by the Registrar, regardless of the outcome of the raffle ticket sales. Failure to hold a draw as specified is a breach of the terms and conditions of this licence.
2. Any incidents, including those related to technical integrity of the gaming system, occurring before or during the electronic raffle event must be reported by the licensee to the Registrar within a specific timeframe. The Notification Matrix - Electronic Raffles (available at www.agco.ca) lists all the incident types that must be reported.
3. Only tickets that have been paid for and/or been verified as paid for are eligible to be entered for respective draw/s. The licensee is to ensure that the requirement is strictly adhered to.

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Any prizes which are not claimed must be secured or placed in safekeeping for a period of six (6) months from the date of the draw. If at the end of six (6) months the prize has been claimed, the prize or monies equivalent to the fair market value of the prize must be donated to a beneficiary approved by the licensing authority.

All winning tickets numbers must be advertised on the website for a minimum of six (6) months from the draw date.
